**TVU Group** in Leutershausen (Bavaria) is one of the largest yarn traders and dyeing mills in Europe. Our 150 employees, of which 12 per cent are apprentices, generate a turnover of approx. EUR 47m. Throughout our existence we have felt a responsibility towards other people and our environment.



#### Always ahead.

Today **sustainability** is a term with positive connotations for most people. Likewise, many consumers wish to buy sustainably, socially-responsible and fairly produced products. The international retail and many labels advertise with terms like **"sustainable"** and **"fair"**. Occasionally the requirements and standards for these certifications are not transparent, difficult to scrutinise, and in some cases regrettably mere whitewashing.

In 2010 we set ourselves visionary ambitious targets for the year 2020 as part of our "Vision 2020". We work with great commitment every day to implement this vision and are delighted at every small success on our long journey.


Yarn dyeing enables the production of textiles with greater durability. For example, yarn-dyed tablecloths can withstand significantly more wash cycles than piecedyed tablecloths, which ultimately leads to less resource consumption.

#### Always open.


We wish to be judged through our transparent figures. From 1 January 2017 our customers get the average annual specific water and CO<sub>2</sub> footprint per kg of finished yarn disclosed on their invoice. This means that over time every customer can understand where we are currently and where we want to go in terms of our development. The relevant data are always available, both for customers and the authorities.

## **ENERGY - PRODUCTION &** RECOVERY.



Our energy concept is absolutely exemplary. We produce our own clean energy, and can recover and reuse it by means of modern technology.

- heat production in our own biomass heating plant
- 60% heat recovery after dyeing
- 13% of electricity requirements provided by photovoltaic systems



# DYES, CHEMICALS & ADDITIVES.



Out of strong conviction, we don't non-degradable pollutants which could accumulate in nature.



REACH regulations, organic textile standards and other statutory regulations only represent the minimum standards we set ourselves.

That's our promise to you and the generations that follow.

#### WATER, WASTEWATER, WASTE.



Efficiency is economical and good for the environment. And because we work efficiently with dyes, chemicals and all other raw materials, we only produce the minimum waste and wastewater necessary.

- exclusive use of process water
- process optimisations led to a 35% reduction in water consumption
- wastewater decolourisation using partial flow treatment before water reaches the local sewage works
- Comprehensive, long-term waste and wastewater statistics available to customers and authorities

#### SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.



In Germany, compliance with social standards is of course regulated and controlled by law. In Leutershausen, our support for our employees exceeds the standard statutory minimum: for instance, we provide funding for childcare costs and invest in preventative health measures.




We hold our suppliers to our own standards and ensure compliance with social standards personally on site.
